# AMERICAN BOARD OF COLON AND RECTAL SURGERY MANDATED CME CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

## CME Requirements At-A-Glance

### Renewal Cycle:

Five-year CME cycle - deadline is December 31 of the final year of each five-year CME cycle

### Minimum CMEs:

- [90 Category 1 CME over the course of every five-year cycle](#)
- [50 of the 90 Category 1 CME must qualify for Self-Assessment with a minimum passing score of 75%](#)

## CME Requirements Detail

Diplomates are required to complete 90 *AMA PRA Category I CME Credits*<sup>™</sup> every five years. A minimum of 50 of the 90 *AMA PRA Category I Credits*<sup>™</sup> must include a Self-assessment Activity. CARSEP or SESAP are recommended; however, any accredited CME activity that provides *AMA PRA Category I Credits*<sup>™</sup>, and a Self-Assessment component (with a passing score of greater than 75%), will be accepted for MOC Part II Self-Assessment.
