CME Requirements At-A-Glance

Renewal Cycle:

Biennial - Licenses expire March 31 of odd-numbered years

State-Mandated CME Requirements:

- 40 Category 1 CME
- 1 CME on Child Abuse and Domestic Violence

State-Mandated CME Content Detail

Licensees must complete 40 Category 1 CME every

two-year renewal cycle. One-hour training meeting the Child Protection

Accountability Commission requirements each two-year renewal cycle. To satisfy

the mandatory training requirement, the board-approved training must address how

to recognize child abuse and domestic violence and provide Delaware-specific

information on reporting child abuse. Physicians

should confirm Delaware's current
