CME Requirements At-A-Glance

Renewal Cycle:

[Biennial – Licenses expire March 31 of odd-numbered years](#)

State-Mandated CME Content Detail

Licensees must complete 40 Category 1 CME every two-year renewal cycle. One-hour training meeting the Child Protection Accountability Commission requirements each two-year renewal cycle. To satisfy the mandatory training requirement, the board-approved training must address how to recognize child abuse and domestic violence and provide Delaware-specific information on reporting child abuse. Physicians should confirm Delaware's current requirements provided by the Delaware Board of Medical Licensure and Discipline.
