CME Requirements At-A-Glance

Renewal Cycle:

[Biennial – Licenses expire December 31 of even-numbered years](#)

State-Mandated CME Requirements:

- [50 CME every two years](#)
- [Minimum of 10% addressing identified Public Health Priorities](#)
- [2 LGBTQ Cultural Competency](#)
- [3 HIV/AIDS](#)
- [1 Pharmacology](#)

State-Mandated CME Content Detail

Physicians must complete fifty (50) hours of CE every two (2) years, which includes three (3) hours in the subject of HIV/AIDS, two (2) hours in the subject of LGBTQ cultural competency, and at least one (1) course in the subject of pharmacology. Licensees must complete at least 10% of the required total addressing the Public Health Priorities identified by the Director of the Department of Health.
