CME Requirements At-A-Glance

Renewal Cycle:

Biennial – Licenses expire on October 31 of odd-numbered years

State-Mandated CME Requirements:

• 2 Opioid Prescribing and Opioid Abuse

State-Mandated CME Content Detail

Each physician or osteopathic physician renewing their controlled substance registration will need to have completed two hours of CME in the topic of Opioid Prescribing and Opioid Abuse. Physicians should confirm Indiana's current requirements provided by the Medical Licensing Board of Indiana.
