STATE-MANDATED CME CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

CME Requirements At-A-Glance

Renewal Cycle:

Annual - Licenses expire June 30 annually (p. 20)

State-Mandated CME Requirements:

- <u>40 Category 1 CME every two years</u>
- <u>5 Prescribing Controlled Substances</u>

State-Mandated CME Content Detail

Every Mississippi licensee must earn or receive not

less than forty (40) hours of Category 1 continuing medical education in a two-year cycle as a condition precedent to renewing his or her license for the next fiscal year. For every Mississippi licensee with an active DEA certificate, five hours must be related to the prescribing of medications with an emphasis on controlled substances. Excess hours may not be carried over to another two-year cycle. For the purpose of this regulation, the two-year period begins July 1, 2000, and every two years thereafter. Physicians
