# CME Requirements At-A-Glance

#### **Renewal Cycle:**

Annual renewal required by licensee's DOB

### **State-Mandated CME Requirements:**

• <u>60 Category 1 CME every three years</u>

#### State-Mandated CME Content Detail

Physicians are required by North Dakota law to complete 60 AMA Category 1 hours of continuing medical education every three years. Each physician's license expires annually on his or her birthdate. Every third year, each physician must certify compliance with the 60 hour CME requirement. Physicians are advised to confirm North Dakota's current requirements with

the North Dakota Board of Medicine.
