CME Requirements At-A-Glance

Renewal Cycle:

Annual renewal on or before June 30

State-Mandated CME Requirements:

- <u>16 AOA Category 1 CME every year</u>
- <u>1 Proper Prescribing every year</u>

State-Mandated CME Content Detail

According to the Oklahoma State Board of Osteopathic

Examiners, osteopathic physicians are required to earn 16 AOA Category 1 CME Credits every year. One hour every year shall be devoted to the subject of the proper prescribing, dispensing, and administering of Controlled Dangerous Substances. This one (1) hour program of CME shall be obtained at a seminar approved by the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners. Physicians are advised to confirm
