PENNSYLVANIA (DO) STATE-MANDATED CME CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

CME Requirements At-A-Glance

Renewal Cycle:

Biennial - Renew by October 31 of even-numbered years

State-Mandated CME Requirements:

- <u>100 CME every two years</u>
- Minimum of 20 Category 1A
- <u>12 Risk Management/Patient Safety</u>
- <u>2 Pain Management/Addiction/Prescribing of Opioids</u>
- <u>2 Child Abuse</u>
- <u>ONE-TIME REQUIREMENT: 3-hour DHS course on Child Abuse Recognition</u> and Reporting
