### SOUTH CAROLINA STATE-MANDATED CME CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

#### CME Requirements At-A-Glance

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**Renewal Cycle:**

[Biennial – Renew by June 30 of odd-numbered years](#)

**State-Mandated CME Requirements:**

- [40 Category 1 CME every two years – 30 of which are specialty related](#)
- [2 Prescribing and Monitoring Controlled Substances](#)

#### State-Mandated CME Content Detail

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Physicians are required to complete 40 hours of continuing medical education every two-year renewal cycle. Thirty of these hours must be in their specialty; 10 may be non-specialty. Two of the 40 CME must address appropriate procedures for prescribing and monitoring controlled substances. These two hours are required every two years regardless of specialty or whether you actually prescribe controlled substances. All hours must be AMA/AOA Category 1 taken within the 2-year renewal period. Physicians should confirm South Carolina's current requirements provided by the [South Carolina Board of Medical Examiners](#).
