State-Mandated CME Requirements:

- [30 CME every two-year renewal cycle – At least 40% must be osteopathic medical education](#)

State-Mandated CME Content Detail

As a condition of renewal, a licensee shall complete a minimum of 30 hours of continuing medical education during the preceding two-year period. At least 40% of these hours must be osteopathic medical education.
