# CME Requirements At-A-Glance

#### **Renewal Cycle:**

**Biennial** 

#### **State-Mandated CME Requirements:**

• 30 CME every two-year renewal cycle – At least 40% must be osteopathic medical education

## State-Mandated CME Content Detail

As a condition of renewal, a licensee shall complete a minimum of 30 hours of continuing medical education during the preceding two-year period. At least 40% of these hours must be osteopathic medical education. Practice
