### WEST VIRGINIA (DO) STATE-MANDATED CME CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

#### CME Requirements At-A-Glance

**Renewal Cycle:**

[Biennial - Renew by June 30 of expiration year](#)

**State-Mandated CME Requirements:**

- [32 CME each two-year renewal cycle](#)
- [Minimum of 16 AOA Category 1A or 1B](#)
- [3 Prescribing Practices \(Board approved\)](#)

#### State-Mandated CME Content Detail

For D.O. Licensure Renewal, the Board requires a total of 32 CME hours, 16 of which must be earned through AOA Category 1A or 1B activities. A three-hour CME course which has been approved by the WV Board of Osteopathic Medicine must be completed by any licensee of the Board who prescribes, administers or dispenses a controlled substance. This will be required every two-year licensing period, unless the licensee signs a board waiver indicating she/he has not administered, prescribed, or dispensed a controlled substance during the last two-year licensing period. Board Approved CME Programs can be found on the WVBOM calendar. Physicians are advised to confirm current requirements with West Virginia's Board of Osteopathic Medicine
