CME Requirements At-A-Glance

Renewal Cycle:

[Biennial renewal by October 31 of odd-numbered years](#)

State-Mandated CME Requirements:

- [30 Category 1 CME every two-year renewal cycle](#)
- [2 Opioid Prescribing \(Board approved\)](#)

State-Mandated CME Content Detail

Licensees are required to complete 30 hours of Category 1 AMA or AOA continuing medical education each two-year renewal cycle. Each license holder is required to take two of the required 30 hours via Board-approved courses on responsible opioid prescription. Multiple courses may be combined that add up to two hours as long as they are all on the approved list. Physicians who do not hold a U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration number to prescribe controlled substances are exempted under the rules. Physicians are advised to confirm Wisconsin's current [requirements with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services](https://dsps.wi.gov/Pages/Professions/Physician/CE.aspx).
